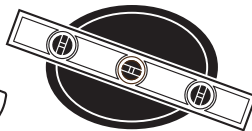




Tools Recommended

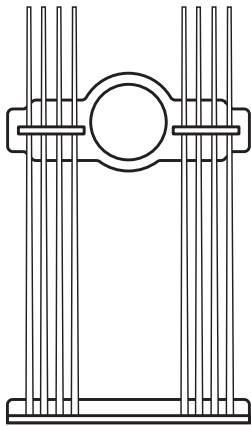

Drill



1) Locate studs in the wall with a stud finder. Properly space the top and bottom pieces according to the recommended dimensions (based on a standard 8 foot ceiling and a standard 32 inch high pool table. Mark with a pencil using the suggested dimensions (on-center) for the locations of the keyhole hangers (top and the bottom pieces)

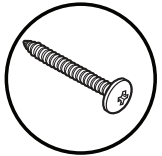
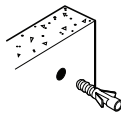
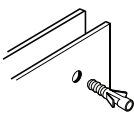
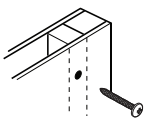
2) Drill holes for the spotted keyhole marks with an appropriate drill bit size (for the type of wall hanger used)

3) Tap or screw the anchors into place in the drilled hole(s). For wood: screw in the required screw with a head that will fit into the keyhole opening as shown. This applies to the anchors as well. Please make sure the anchors are flush with the wall surface.

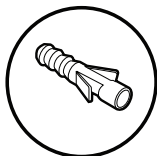
4) Position the top and bottom pieces over the screw heads and locate and lock in position the keyhole hangers as shown. The top and bottom pieces should be aligned and flush to the wall.

5) You may now place your cue sticks (up to 8) into the cue stick top ledge holes & bottom felt lined stick butt nest.

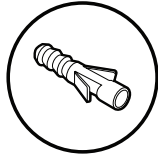

Hollow



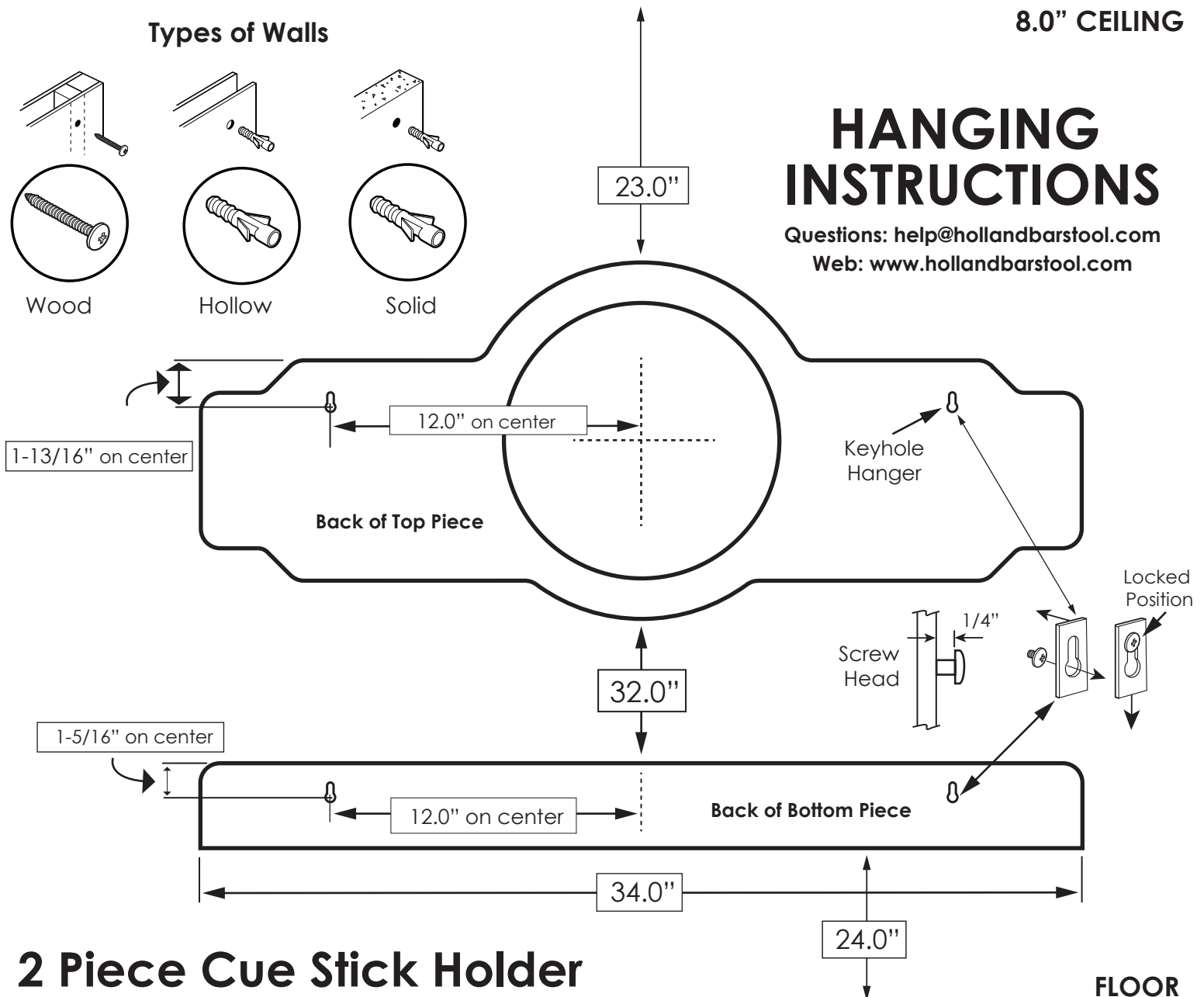
Solid
